Surrender/crisis animal support

Paws & Recover

- Often get foster carers for animals for Women escaping DV (I've had a client use their service & she was happy with it).
- It is a requirement that people have their pets vaccinations up to date, microchipped, desexed, etc & this can be an obstacle for women accessing this type of support due to not having the money to get these things done.
- Paws & Recover offer an option to get animals desexed whilst in foster care.
- They are a short-term option for 1-3 months only.

RSPCA Safe Beds for Pets is difficult to access, they charge a minimal daily boarding fee but if you have no money, it's a lot, they are also all the way at Yagoona so The Woman would have to be able to get her pets there & it's very hard to get a vacancy.

RSPCA Safe Beds for Pets

- Families needing assistance from Safe Beds for Pets can contact them directly through their hotline, which operates Monday-Friday, 9 am-5 pm.
- Can speak to any of the caseworkers to get help for their pets.
- They charge a minimal daily boarding fee.
- Located at Yagoona, so transport must be considered.
- Domestic violence services can also make a referral or inquiry on behalf of the client
- Very limited vacancy

- Mostly cats- desexing assistance October-May every year
- Hawkesbury Valley is a branch of Animal Welfare League NSW.
- Rescues dogs and cats and kittens from the local Hawkesbury Companion Animal Shelter and other shelters in Sydney.
- The Animal Welfare League NSW Hawkesbury Branch promotes responsible pet ownership, including desexing animals before breeding age and microchipping as these measures will help to decrease the large numbers of surrendered, lost, and abandoned pets.
- Can assist financially in desexing your pet via the Companion Animal Assistance Scheme (CAAS).
- Available to pensioners and low-income earners in the Hawkesbury area.
- All dogs and cats are rehomed desexed, vaccinated, vet checked, microchipped, and ready for their new home.

Crisis Foster Care

RSPCA NSW Community Domestic Violence Program

- Sydney metropolitan-based service that builds partnerships with local kennels/shelters/organisations in regional areas.
- The only established specialist crisis fosters care program available in this area.
- HOWEVER, often unable to offer their program locally
- Primarily dogs and cats but ask about any animal.

Below is some information from their website:

"Through our Domestic Violence program, RSPCA NSW aims to offer practical solutions for pet owners leaving situations of domestic violence. We safely house and care for their pets, allowing them time to find a safe refuge for themselves, to reunite them with their beloved pet as soon as possible.

- Services of our Domestic Violence program include temporary foster accommodation and/or emergency pet boarding
- financial assistance for veterinary treatment
- financial assistance with impound fees
- financial assistance with transport fees
